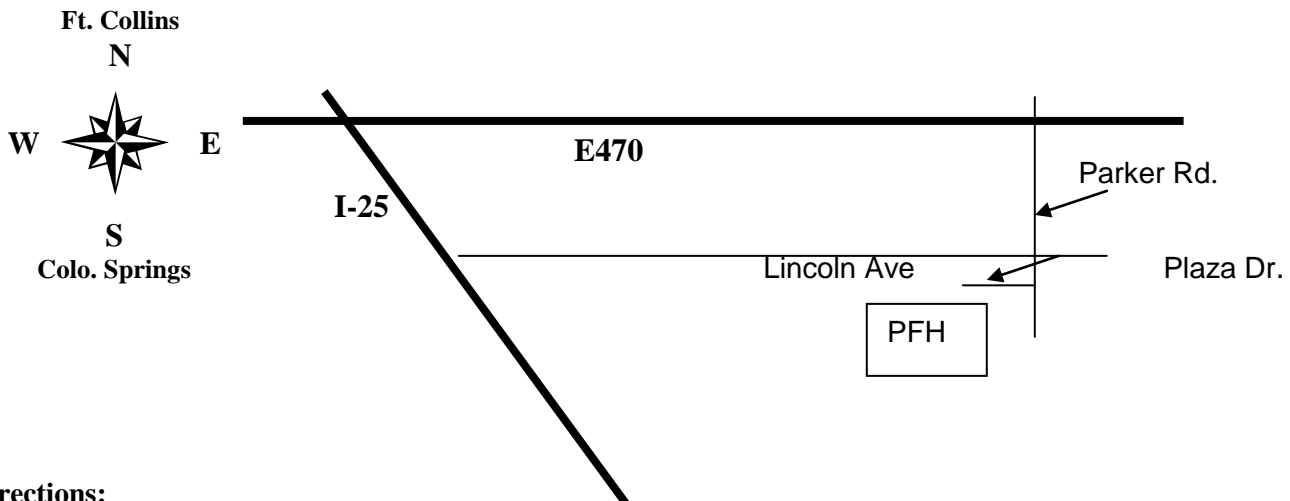

Survey Feedback

Thank you for taking the time in filling out the surveys we sent last year. This gave us valuable information to discuss in our January Board of Directors meeting. In light of the survey we have made some changes we think that you the membership will enjoy.

Team Forms

Interest was expressed in having a Team Forms division. We agree that this could be a very fun and exciting division. We will have (3) new divisions. Junior, Adult, and Combined team forms. These divisions will consist of two or more competitors and will follow the Open/Musical rules.

Competition Age

It seems every year competitors lose points because they are unaware of how our competition age rule worked. This was especially true with new competitors of competitors new to the CKA. Competitors felt penalized because after their birthday they had to move into a new division and lost the points they had already earned. We heard your concern and have made changes to alleviate this problem in the future.

New Competition Age Rule

A junior Competitors' competition age is the age he/she is on January 1st of that year. A junior competitor will have the option of "competing up" in age. Some junior competitors may feel that they would like to better challenge themselves by moving up to an older division. This can be done from one junior division to another. Points earned stay in the division they were earned in and do not follow the competitor. A junior may not compete in an adult division.

Team Championships

Another concept brought up was the idea of a CKA Team State Champion. This is another great idea. Because of the different sizes of schools we felt it only fair to have two different divisions. In the future we may expand it. Points will be earned through support, participation, and results.

1. Points earned per competitor
2. Points earned from volunteers (Judges, Score/Time Keeper)
3. Points earned through competitors placing. (1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc.)

Schools that bring on average 10 or less competitors are in Division 3A. Schools that bring on average 11 or more competitors are Division 5A. At the end of each season the Team State Champions will be awarded a banner to hang in their school.

Instructors: Please be sure to have your team members use the exact same school name or abbreviation when filling out the entry form.

Tournament Rules

All Point Sparring and Forms divisions will adhere to the 2010 CKA Rules

Coaching: Coaching is allowed in all sparring divisions. The coach must have a valid coaching pass and must wear it in plain view while inside the competition area.

Bracketing: In order to be as fair as possible to all competitors, bracketing will be done by random draw at ringside.

Point Sparring: *Point Values to any legal target:* One point is scored for a hand strike or body kick. Two points are scored for a controlled kick to the head or spinning kick to the body. 3 points for any aerial or spinning kick to the head, or jump spinning body kick. *Legal Target Areas:* Head & Face, Sides of Neck, Chest, Abdominal Area, Torso, Kidneys. The Groin is a legal target in adult Intermediate and above divisions only. *Illegal Target Areas:* Throat, Back of Neck, Spine, Legs, Knees, Head on a downed opponent.
